

### Workforce Wages


Wages for Early Childhood Educators in Idaho are some of the lowest in any occupation across the state.<sup>2</sup>



Early educators' poverty-level wages are compounded by a lack of access to basic health and well-being supports like health insurance and paid sick leave. The pandemic brought into focus the severe consequences of these long-standing realities, as many educators have been forced to choose between a paycheck or their own health and safety and that of their families. (Early Childhood Educator Workforce Index 2020)<sup>3</sup>
